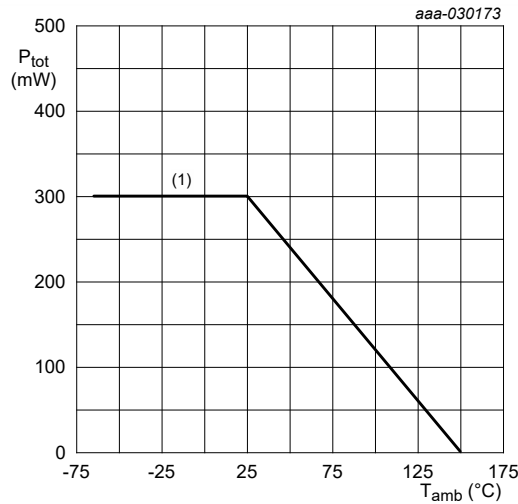

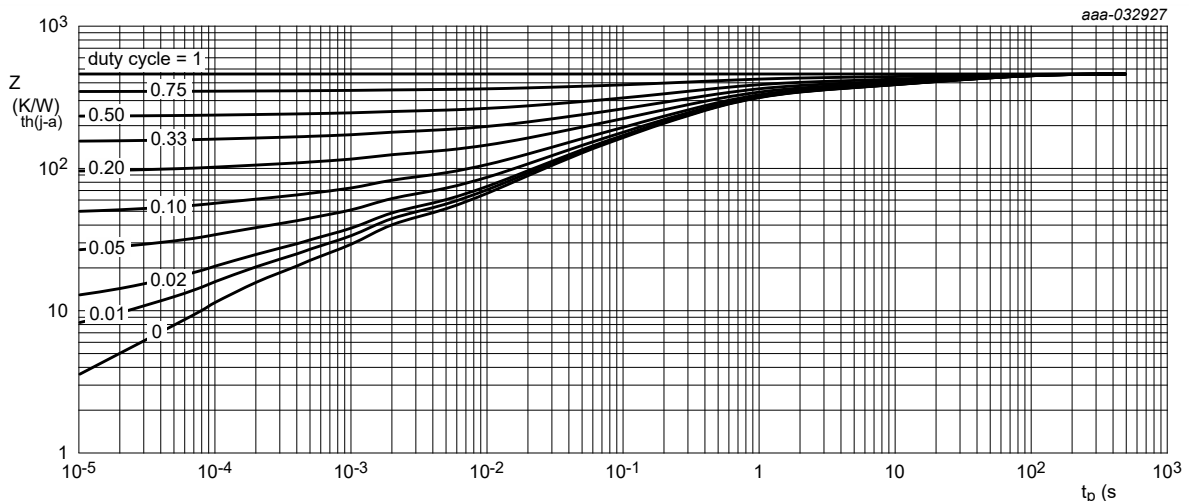
Fig. 1. Per device: Power derating curves

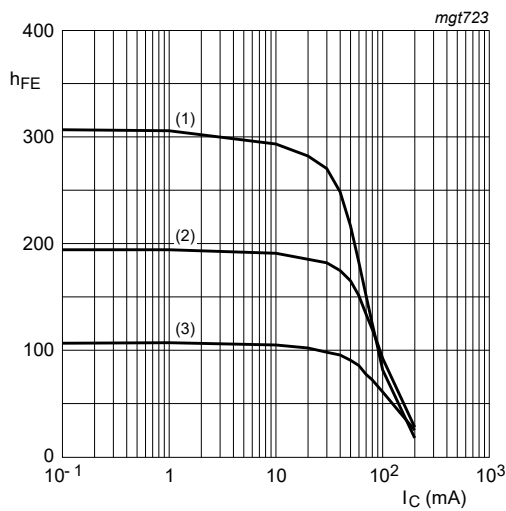
FR4 PCB, single-sided, 35 μm copper, tin-plated and standard footprint

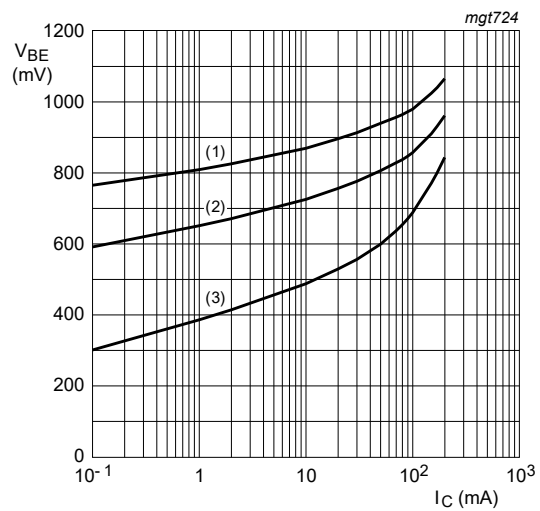

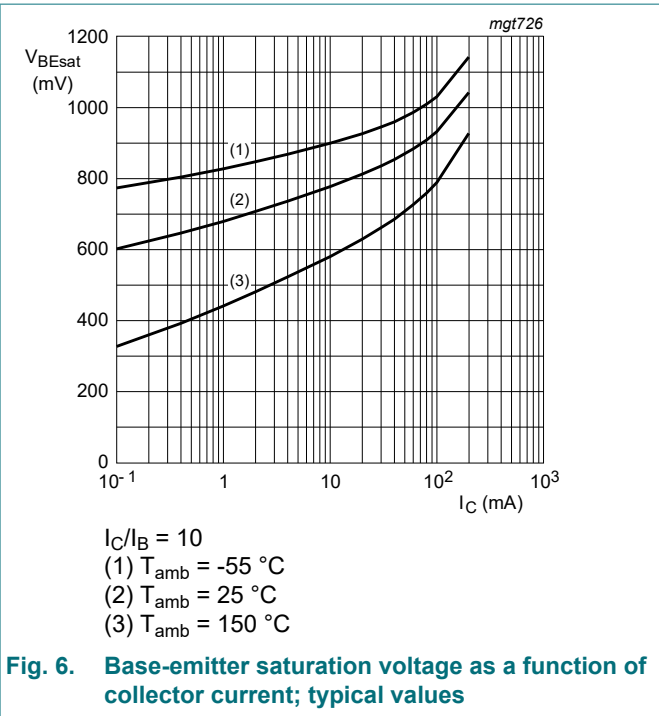
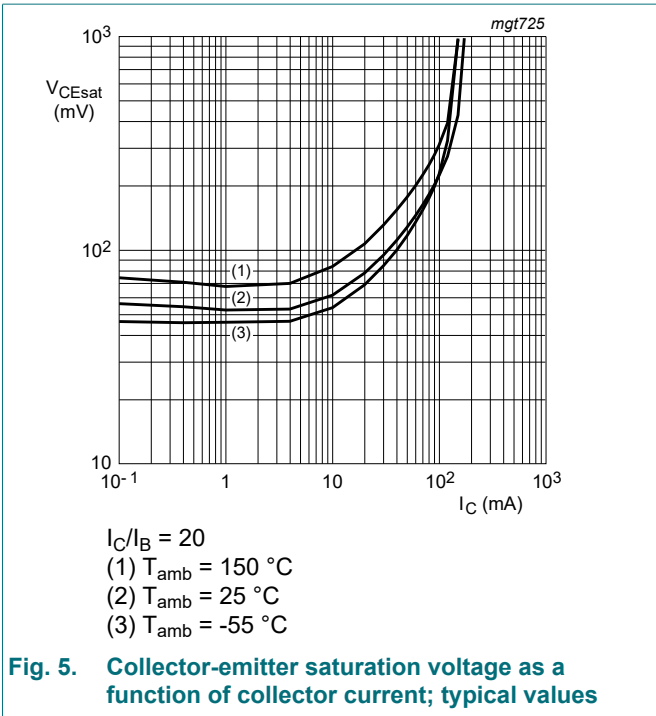

Fig. 3. DC current gain as a function of collector current; typical values

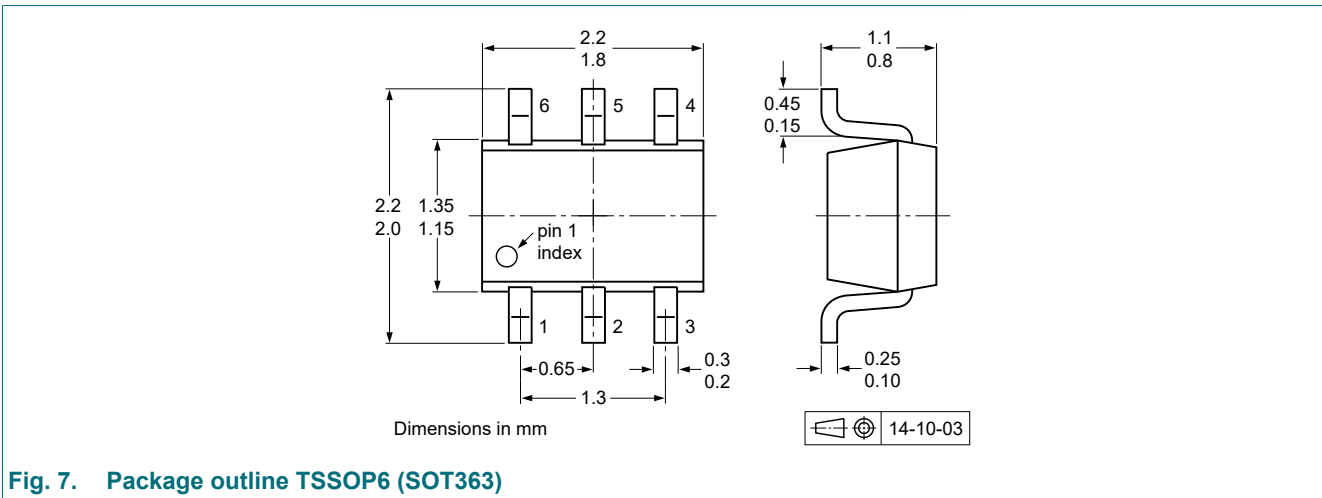

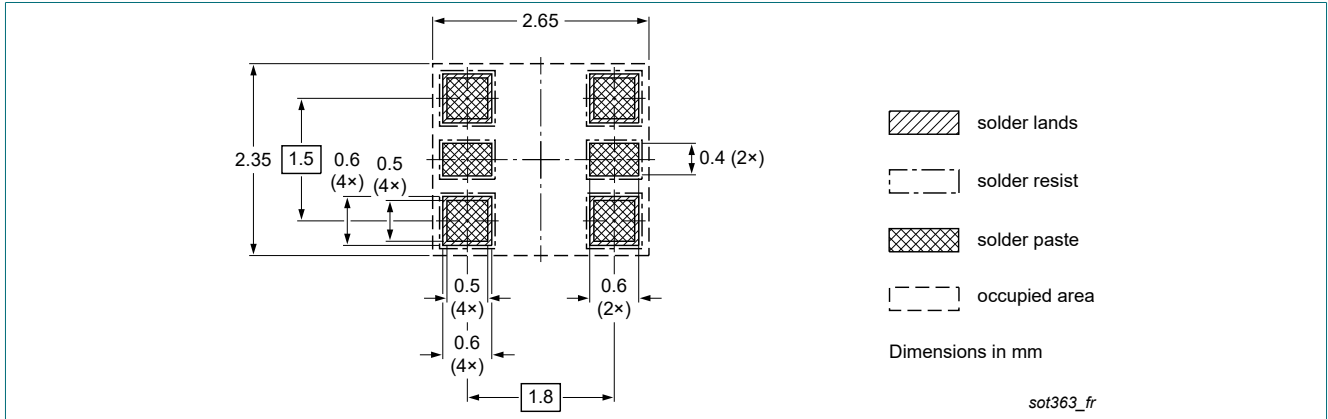


Fig. 8. Reflow soldering footprint for TSSOP6 (SOT363)

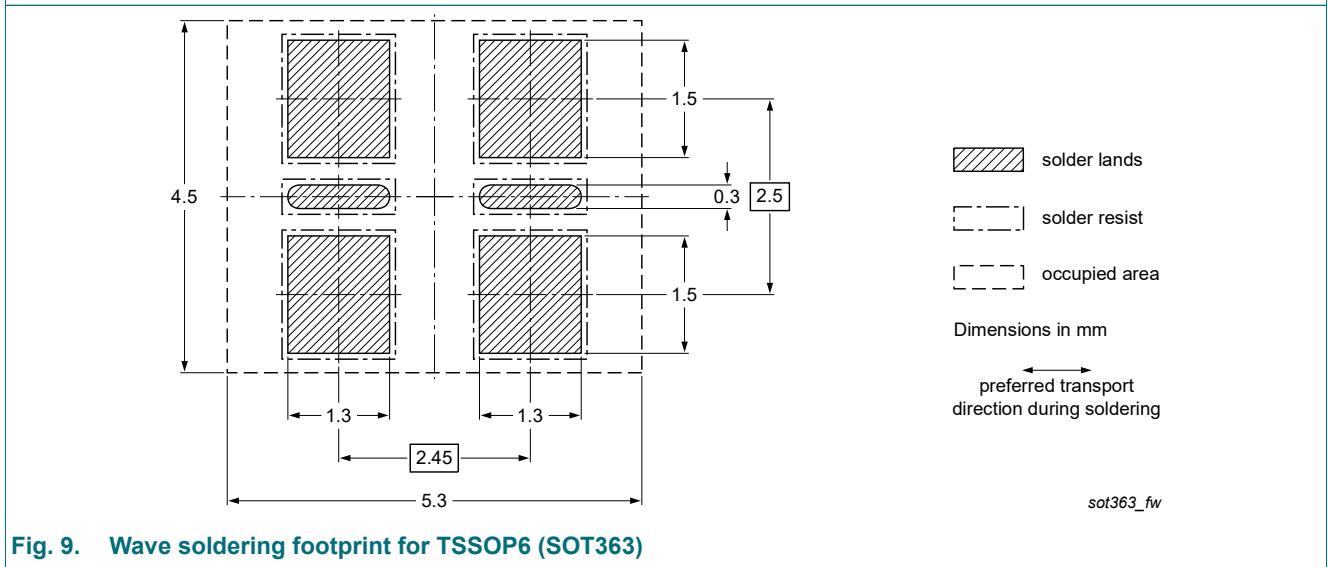


Fig. 9. Wave soldering footprint for TSSOP6 (SOT363)
