# Low-Voltage 1.8/2.5/3.3V 16-Bit Transparent Latch

With 26 $\Omega$  Series Resisters and 3.6V-Tolerant Inputs and Outputs (3-State, Non-Inverting)

The 74VCX162373 is an advanced performance, non-inverting 16-bit transparent latch. It is designed for very high-speed, very low-power operation in 1.8 V, 2.5 V or 3.3 V systems. The VCX162373 is byte controlled, with each byte functioning identically, but independently. Each byte has separate Output Enable and Latch Enable inputs. These control pins can be tied together for full 16-bit operation.

When operating at 2.5~V (or 1.8~V) the part is designed to tolerate voltages it may encounter on either inputs or outputs when interfacing to 3.3~V busses. It is guaranteed to be over–voltage tolerant to 3.6~V.

The 74VCX162373 contains 16 D–type latches with 3–state 3.6 V–tolerant outputs. It is designed with 26 $\Omega$  series resistors in each of the outputs to reduce noise. When the Latch Enable (LEn) inputs are HIGH, data on the Dn inputs enters the latches. In this condition, the latches are transparent, (a latch output will change state each time its D input changes). When LE is LOW, the latch stores the information that was present on the D inputs a setup time preceding the HIGH–to–LOW transition of LE. The 3–state outputs are controlled by the Output Enable  $(\overline{OEn})$  inputs. When  $\overline{OE}$  is LOW, the outputs are enabled. When  $\overline{OE}$  is HIGH, the standard outputs are in the high impedance state, but this does not interfere with new data entering into the latches.




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#### MARKING DIAGRAM





Figure 1. 48-Lead Pinout (Top View)








#### **WAVEFORM 1 - PROPAGATION DELAYS**

#### **WAVEFORM 2 - OUTPUT ENABLE AND DISABLE TIMES**








Figure 5. Test Circuit


Figure 7. AC Waveforms




Figure 9. Carrier Tape Specifications




Figure 10. Reel Dimensions




Figure 11. Reel Winding Direction




Figure 12. Tape Ends for Finished Goods






Figure 13. Reel Configuration
