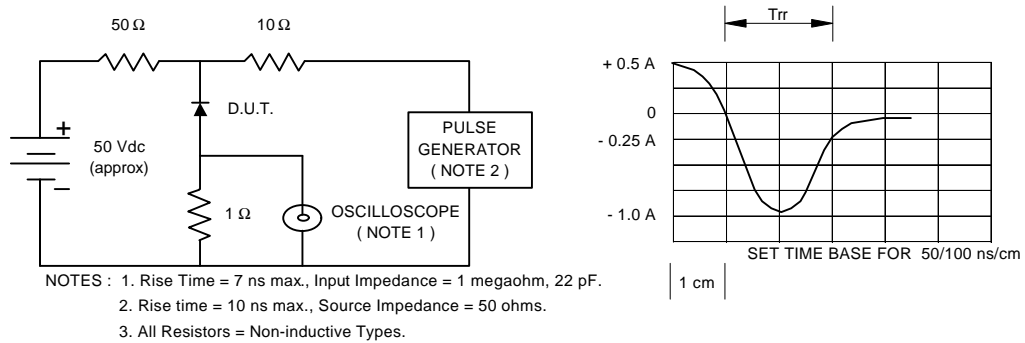

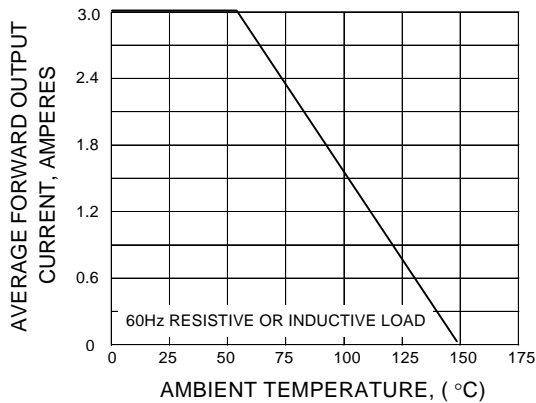

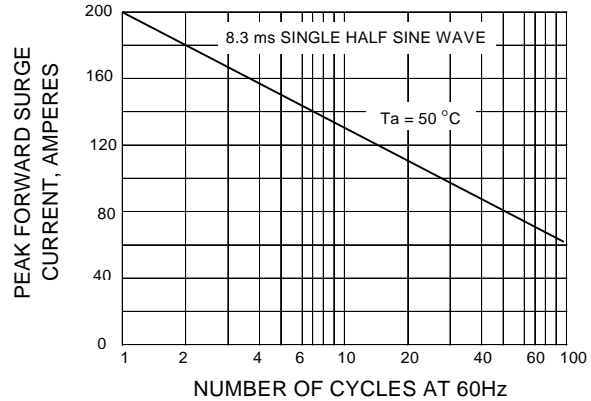
**FIG.1 - REVERSE RECOVERY TIME CHARACTERISTIC AND TEST CIRCUIT DIAGRAM**



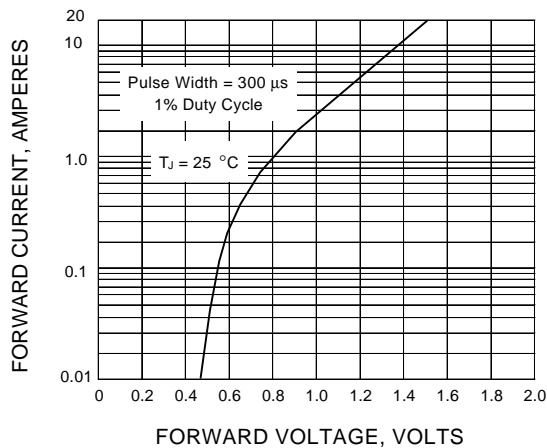
**FIG.2 - DERATING CURVE FOR OUTPUT RECTIFIED CURRENT**
