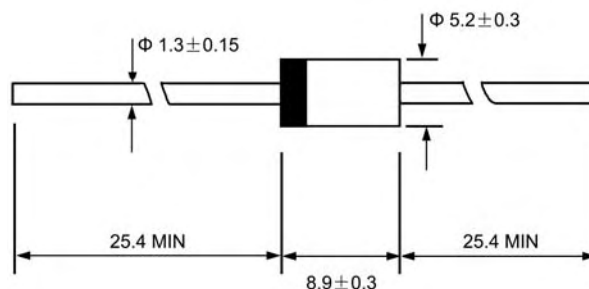
Features

FIG.1 – TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTIC

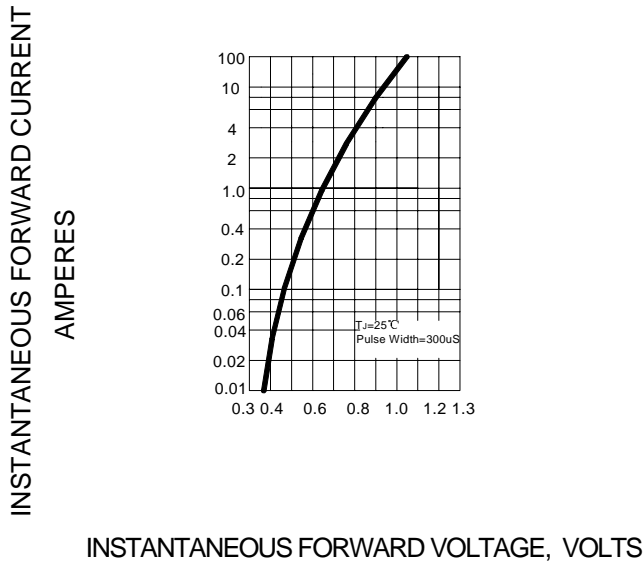


FIG.2- FORWARD DERATING CURVE

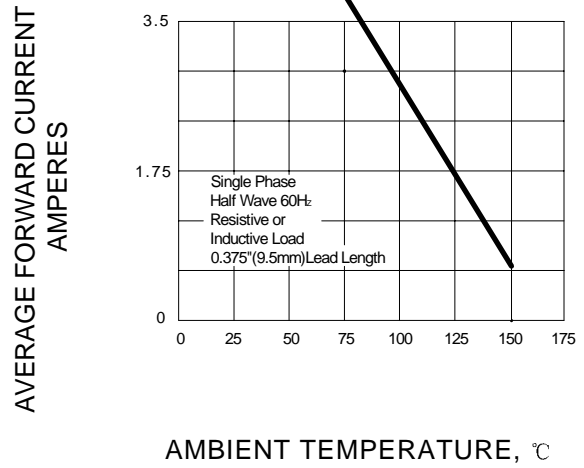


FIG.3- PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT

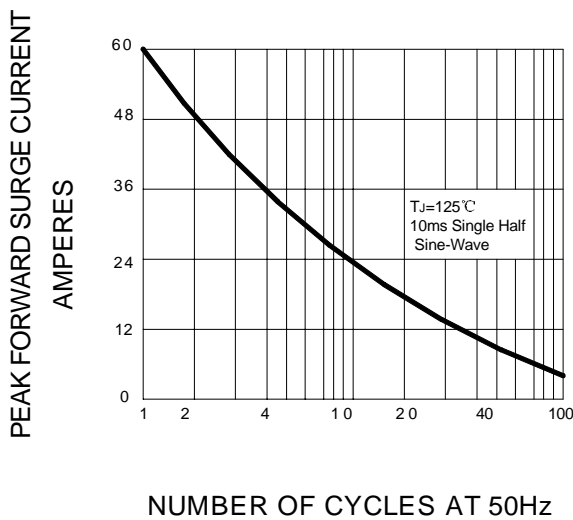


FIG.4 – TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS
