



Figure 5. Output Current vs. Input Voltage





Figure 6. Input Voltage vs. Output Current

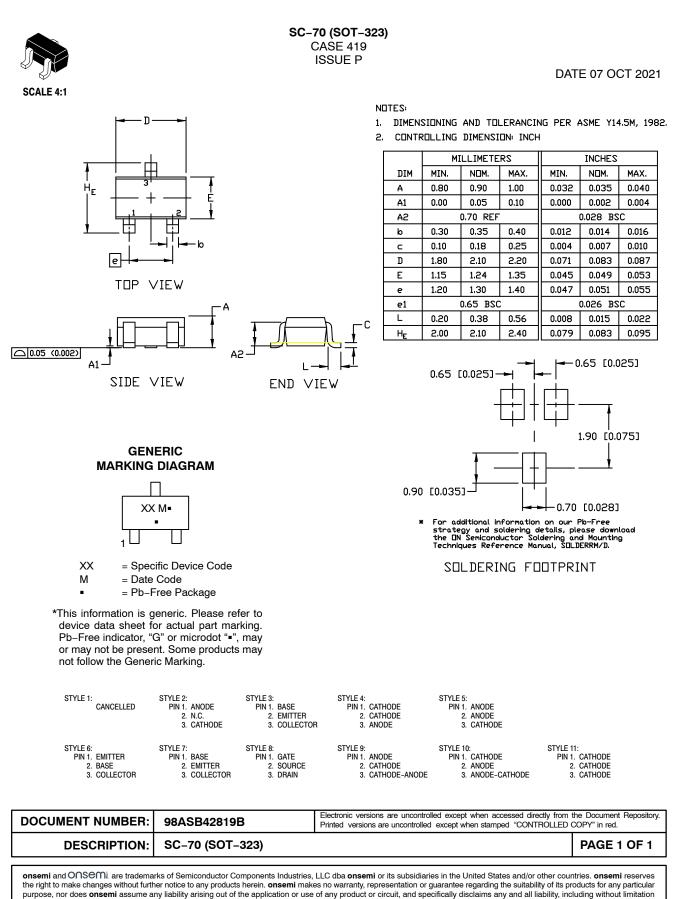

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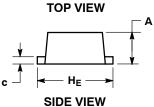

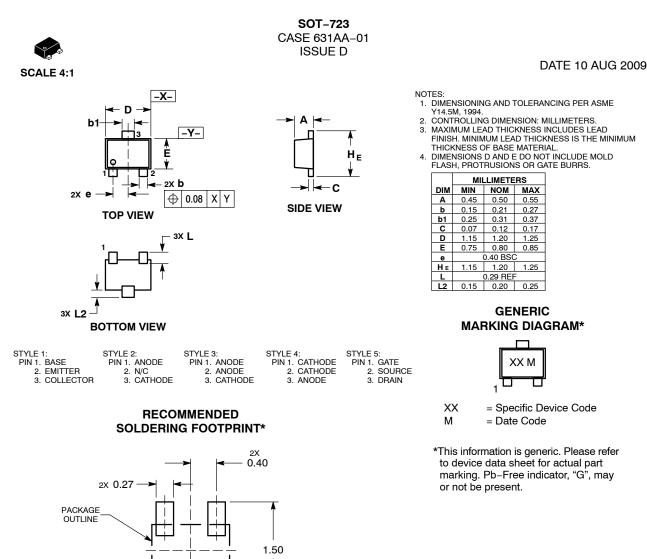
