


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
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





Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage








Single Pulse Power, Junction-to-Ambient



Safe Operating Area, Junction-to-Ambient





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 $T_{\mbox{\scriptsize C}}$ - Case Temperature (°C)

T_A - Ambient Temperature (°C)




